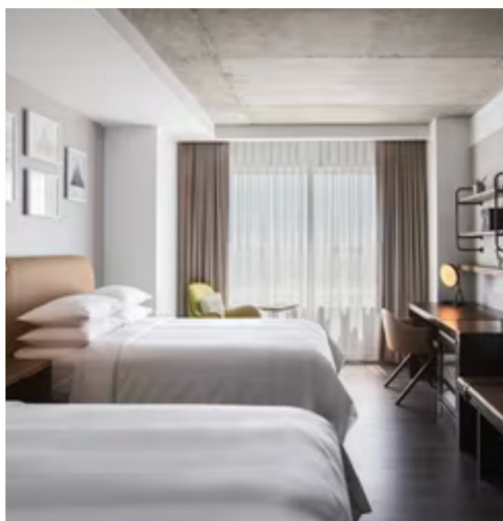

DAY 2: TRANSFER TO AIKEN, SC

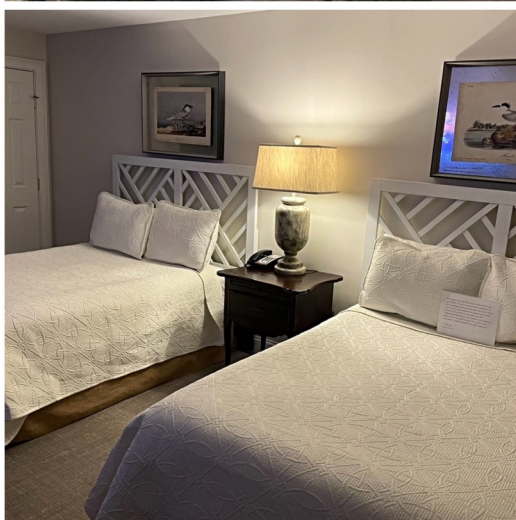
Group transfer to Aiken, SC (approx. a 2.5-hour drive from Atlanta to Aiken).

The Carriage House Inn is a charming Southern boutique hotel located close to Aiken's historic Downtown area which is filled with great restaurants and bars.

DAY 3: PRACTICE DAY AT US MASTERS

We head off this morning to Augusta National for the Practice Day at the Masters. This is a great chance to take photos of the course and players, as cameras are not permitted during the tournament days. **Please note that iPhones etc. are not allowed inside Augusta National at any time**, so please pack a traditional camera.

Our insider tip is that today is also the best day to shop for souvenirs as some may run out by the end of the week. We highly recommend you buy a souvenir Masters chair which can be placed anywhere on the course and will remain vacant until you return to them – a great Masters tradition.

For some fun today you are advised to spend some time at the Par 3, 16th hole as players try to skip the ball over the pond and onto the green.



4-7pm: It is a casual walk back to our Augusta hospitality zone. The TV is showing highlights, everyone is on a high and you will enjoy complimentary drinks and delicious canapés with your hosts and friends. Discuss the day's highlights and your first day at Augusta. Regular transfers are also provided back to your hotel for your convenience.

Evening: This evening is yours to enjoy. If you would like a little guidance as to where to go and what to do, just let us know and we can help. As the week gets busier we would recommend booking at one of our favourite restaurants, which we can help you with.

DAY 4: GOLF AT PALMETTO (including Cart and light Lunch)

Morning: 7:00 am start the day with a fully cooked breakfast cooked at your hotel.

Palmetto Golf Course is a private members-only course located in Aiken. Non-Members can only play at Palmetto during Masters Week each year. The course, considered the 2nd oldest 18 hole course in the USA (after Chicago Golf Club), was designed by Alistair McKenzie just after he completed Augusta National.

We choose to play at Palmetto so you can have a taste of what it would be like to play Augusta. Whilst it does not have the luxurious clubhouse and surroundings like many private American courses, it makes up for it with its history and challenge.

A light lunch is included at the club after your golf so you can talk through the highlights of the round.



OPTIONAL ALTERNATIVE – Masters Practice & Par 3 Contest (additional cost)

Or if you are looking for something different, today you can elect head to Augusta to watch players practice before viewing the traditional **Par 3 Contest at the Masters** in the afternoon. Within the grounds of Augusta, there is a picturesque 11-hole Par 3 golf course. This is a fun afternoon watching some of the legends of the game as well as many of the rising stars having a relaxing game before the serious play begins. The Par 3 usually starts at 12:00pm.

DAY 5: DAY AT LEISURE

Few towns in the Southeast offer more gracious charm than **Aiken, South Carolina**. Aiken is simply stunning, at a great place for your first night on tour. Known as the “polo capital of the South”, it’s a place where horses still have right of way and diverse southern history can be viewed through its beautiful historic homes and museums. This is a very relaxing way to unwind and rest after a few days of golf.

Alternatively, you could find yourself at a local sports bar to settle in and watch the action of the First Round at the Masters on a big screen in the afternoon,

DAY 6: GOLF AT OLD BARNWELL (including lunch)

The newest addition to the Aiken golf scene, Old Barnwell opened in 2023. Nestled on 575 acres of sandy soil and rolling hills surrounded by towering longleaf and loblolly pines, Old Barnwell is a private national club near historic Aiken, that allows members of the public have access only during Masters Week.

This 18-hole gem requires strategy, shot-making, and a sense of humour. Created with inspiration from English heathland courses like Woodhall Spa and Swinley Forest, Old Barnwell presents top-flight players with an old-school challenge that invites craft and creativity, while still offering an enjoyable, non-intimidating experience for the high handicapper and beginner.

Lunch at the club is included with your green fees.



OR: OPTIONAL ADD ON—FRIDAY AT THE MASTERS ROUND 2

You can upgrade your Masters Week Package to include an additional Day attending the Second Round of the Tournament (additional cost to be advised at time of booking)

Follow your favourite group around the course or place your deck chair at Amen Corner and watch all the groups come through. Head towards the 18th as players attempt to make "the cut" for the final two rounds.

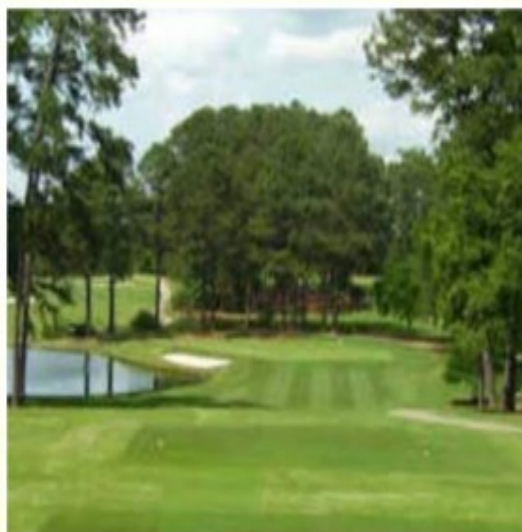
Saturday

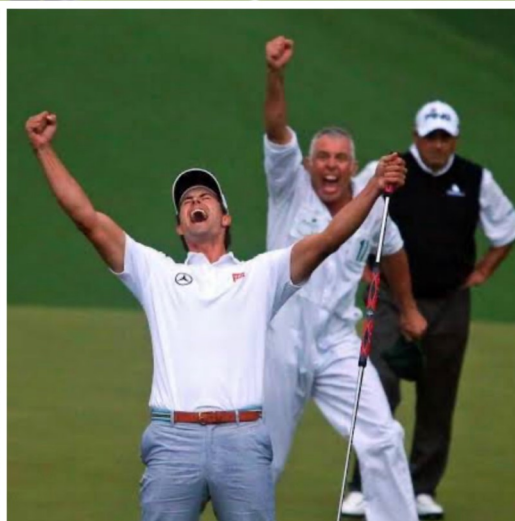

Today you will attend the final day's play of the US Masters Tournament. As soon as you get there, place your chair around the 18th green or fairway so you will be able to see the climax of the tournament. Wander the fairways following the leaders or base yourself at the 16th where Tommy Fleetwood scored a hole-in-one in 2021 and Stewart Cink did as well in 2022.

Transfers back to your hotel will be available until 30 minutes after the presentation of the Green Jacket for the winner.

DAY 9: CHECKOUT AND TRANSFER TO ATLANTA

After an amazing week of golf on some of the world's best courses and US Masters action, today you will be transferred from Aiken to Atlanta International Airport (approx. 2.5 hours drive). The coach will pick you up at 9:00am.

Please make sure you book flights that leave between 2pm – 5pm from Atlanta airport. You will need to book a private transfer to Atlanta at additional cost for flights leaving outside these times.—

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why don't we attend the Masters every day?

Apart from the high cost of the tickets, we have found that over the years you get too tired walking the course every day. You are often surprised at how steep the course is. Additionally, after watching golf for two or three days, many of our past guests prefer to go and hit some balls! 85% of previous attendees tell us that going on our chosen days gives a good balance. However, we are flexible as to the days you attend the Masters, and can arrange for you to attend additional days.

Why don't we stay in Augusta?

We choose not to stay in Augusta due to its limited accommodation and restaurant choices. Furthermore, traffic can be very heavy getting to the course from the north side where most people stay. In contrast, Aiken services a wealthy horse breeding area so the quality of restaurants and hotels are higher. It is only a 30 minute drive to the Augusta National course, avoiding the heavy traffic. 96% of attendees rated Aiken as an admirable alternative to be based. Many tour operators in Australia also do not escort the tour personally, choosing to simply sell a tour on behalf of a local operator based in Augusta where guests are left to their own devices, often making the trip more demanding and risky. Other operators book you into hotels in Colombia which can be a 90 minute drive to Augusta with traffic.

Are non-golfers welcome?

Yes! We welcome non-golfers, and in Aiken there are plenty of activities to fill the day. There are many shops and restaurants in Aiken's historic Downtown area. We would recommend they attend at least one day at The Masters to appreciate the beauty of the course. In Aiken there are also day trips that can be arranged, for example, horse treks, massages and plenty of shopping! A 1 hour spa package at the Willcox Inn Spa is also included in the Non-Golfer

QUESTIONS YOU SHOULD ASK OTHER TOUR OPERATORS:

- Do their tours put strangers together to share houses and bathrooms in Augusta or does everyone have their own room and bathroom?
- Do the tours stay in nice hotels close to Augusta, or, are they in 2* and 3* motels on major highways in places like Colombia or Atlanta where transport to the course is difficult?
- Do tour guides with US Masters experience accompany the group or do they just sell US tour companies' packages rebranded as their own, and guests are left to their own devices?
- How do they source their Masters tickets? Can they give you a letter to email from their ticket supplier confirming ticket availability?
- How long have they been running tours to the Masters?
- Can you see testimonials from previous attendees?

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PAYMENT INFORMATION

A non-refundable deposit of AUD\$1,000 per person is to accompany the booking. A second non-refundable deposit of AUS\$3,000 is due on 10 April 2024. Teed Up recommends that you take out Travel Insurance at this time, as this is less than 12 months from the tour departure date. The Final Payment, is be due on 1 October 2024.

The final payment will be for the full tour price in USD converted to AUD based on the best USD sell rate from the Major 4 banks as at 10am on 30/09/24. The deposit will then be deducted from this to give the balance owing. No refunds are available after this date. You can lock in a \$USD rate with our FX advisors within 12 months of the tour departure date if you wish. Please contact us to secure a quote. If you do lock in a \$USD rate once your deal is confirmed it becomes legally binding and full payment must be made within 5 working days to our account shown on the Booking Form. Alternatively, you may contact Teed Up for details about paying for the tour in US Dollars to Teed Up's US Dollar bank account.

CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations by the client must be in writing or email to Teed-Up Golf Tours and are subject to the following forfeit of cost per person: If cancellation is due to any travel restrictions imposed by the Australian Government and this tour is unable to proceed, refunds will be issued. Please note that all tour payments, including the Final Payment, are NON-REFUNDABLE. It is essential that you obtain Travel Insurance (see below) before you make the Final Payment. Travel Insurance can be purchased 12 months from the date of the tour. Teed Up reserves the right to cancel or reschedule any tour departure in accordance with operating requirements or circumstances beyond our control. Teed Up* is not responsible for any costs for other travel arrangements affected due to our cancellations or rescheduling of any tour departure.

TWIN SHARE & NON-GOLFER SINGLE PACKAGES

If you select a "Twin Share" package you must nominate at the time of booking who you are sharing with otherwise you will be recorded and charged the price of a Single package.

TICKET PRICING

Pricing for these packages have been based on the estimated US Masters ticket prices for the tournament at this time. While we do pay a large non-refundable deposit for tickets when you book with us, our licensed ticket supplier, who we have been using for over 15 years, we can only confirm the ticket prices in the December prior to the tournament. Due to very high increases in US Masters ticket prices at short notice over the past two years we may be forced to increase the cost of the tour package up to, and including, when your final tour balance is due. If there is more than a 5% increase in the tour package at that time we will give you the opportunity to withdraw from the tour and obtain full refund of deposit paid.

IMPORTANT – TRAVEL INSURANCE

It is vital you have Insurance in case you need to cancel for health or other reasons. You can obtain Insurance within 12 months of departure.

VISAS, HEALTH & IMMIGRATION

You should familiarise yourself with any health or visa requirements that may be applicable in the areas you intend visiting. You are responsible for all exit, entry, health and other documents required by laws, regulations, offers demands or requirements of the countries visited or transited. Each person shall carry a valid passport (for international travel) (with a least six months validity) Teed Up* cannot accept responsibility for your failure to ensure that you have correct travel information.
